Deadlines: All artwork must be submitted with a completed entry form by **January 20, 2019**. Please include your name and the title of your work with your entry.

Media: (2-D only) Illustrations, sketches, drawings, paintings, photographs, computer generated images, mixed media, etcetera. *Artwork must not exceed 36 inches tall by 36 wide and must be ready to hang.* Artists should submit a paragraph description (100 words or less) along with their artwork.

Judging: A committee of judges will select the winners based on originality, clarity, quality of execution and relevance to the theme.

Loss, Damage, and Return of Art: All entries will become the property of the Orange County Heritage Council (OCHC). Art will be released at the end of the Culture Fair, February 3, 2017. The OCHC cannot accept responsibility for any damage or loss. By entering the contest and submitting the entry form, entrants agree to release and hold harmless the OCHC and associates, including the panel of judges from all liability for loss or damage to their entered artwork.
